\*All students will be given the opportunity to earn their Hunter Safety and Archery Safety certificates.

**Students must meet one or more of the following criteria in order to be eligible for a scholarship:**

- Limited to no experience in hunting and the outdoors.
- Lack of family financial resources to attend a program of this nature.
- Lack of an active mentor to expose them to outdoor activities.
- Not yet having earned a Michigan Hunter Safety Certificate.
